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OUR STORY

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth -Palestine began its mission and work when His Beatitude Patriarch Michel Sabbah, who worked with youth movements in the Middle East and internationally, created a youth movement in the Holy Land in 1964, so work began through parishes under the umbrella of the Council of Catholic Bishops in the Holy

Land, and under the supervision and the administration of the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem.

The Youth of Jesus' Homeland consists of 14 members (committee leaders and YJHP administration) and 42 committee members who serve about 3,500 Christian (approximately 7-35 years old) who belong to more than 18 parishes, many Catholic schools and different churches in eight Palestinian governorates.

The youth service was founded, from the beginning, on the apostolic work and volunteering, following the verse "I came that they might have life" (John 10:10) as its motto, out of its belief that the Lord Christ is the giver of life, and he calls us to live it in its entirety so that it is supported by God's word, the sacraments, and Christian values and principles. On this basis, Christian youth will change their lives, and work to spread faith and life to others in the Church and Palestinian society, which will enhance values in them in a way that can be turned into reality in all areas of their lives.

Mission: Empowering the youth by integrating them into society and the church by providing Christian education in all its programs, activities, camps, and programs that YJHP provides.

- Encouraging volunteer work and pioneering projects that build and influence the Palestinian community.







Verse of the Year

n December 8, 2020, His Holiness Pope Francis declared 2021, a year dedicated to Saint Joseph, on the occasion Of the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of Saint Joseph, the patron saint of the Church.

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland" chose this year from the words addressed to Saint Joseph by the Lord through the angel, namely: "Get Up, do not be afraid." These words are an appropriate expression for the situation in which the child's divine guardian was living, as we live with almost the same situations, difficulties, challenges and problems. Saint Joseph lived through fear, pain, and lack of understanding



of what was happening with the woman he wanted to marry in order to build a family full of love. What the angel asks of Saint Joseph is the act of resurrection: "Get up," which is an act of command, expressing God's infinite confidence in him, and God's life-giving work in Saint Joseph's life, and this act was used by Jesus himself later in his public life, and it is the same act that was used by Evangelists to express the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.

The other words are: "Do not be afraid", an expression of God's love and God's trust in Saint Joseph. God puts all his trust in man asking him to overcome all his fears by taking the Virgin Mary to his home, protecting the child, and naming him "Jesus". Fear is one of the things that makes a person's life complicated and incomprehensible, and he cannot take a single step in a new stage because of his fear. Therefore, the angel asks Saint Joseph not to be afraid, because God is with him, and he will be his shield.

Almost every day in our lives, we talk to people who express their fear and anxiety about many things (which is a general fear). We are also often afraid: we may be afraid of what people think of us, we may be afraid of not having enough money, we may be afraid to express our opinions in certain situations, and there are special fears for each individual such as who is afraid of certain animals, certain insects, fear of failure, and some are afraid of rejection by others, loneliness, darkness, loss of a family member or loved one, illness, pain or even death!

We all need God's peace in the midst of the stresses in our lives. But how many times is the word fear mentioned in the Bible? "Do not be afraid!" It is the most frequent thing in the Bible. In fact, it has been said there are 365 "Don't be afraid!" In the Bible, the commandment "Do not be afraid" was said once for every day of the year! God always wants us to feel reassured, so He tells us this reassuring word: "Do not be afraid!"

Dear Youth, God calls us as He called Joseph. He loves us as He loved Joseph. He strengthens us as he strengthened Joseph. He calls us not to be afraid. He asks us to Get Up, to leave the past and our fears and move forward.

Let us be the act of resurrection, as Jesus did!

Let us be courageous, as is the gift of the Holy Spirit!

And let us chant out loud: "We are youth who are not afraid, and with the resurrection we will win."

ANNUAL ACTIVITIES

Renewing The Promise

Lere we are again, The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland" renewing the promise of the members of the General Secretariat and Committees for Christian Youth in Palestine for the year 2021, "the last year of the current General Secretariat" by holding a mass at the Holy Family Church - Ramallah. The Mass was presided over by His Beatitude Pierbattista Pizzaballa, Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem. During the festive mass, the General Chaplain, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, and the General Secretary, Mr. Rafi Ghattas, along with the rest of the General Secretariat's members renewed the promise. After that, the General Secretary appointed the members of the committees who fulfilled the promise of service in the General Secretariat of Youth.



At the end of the Holy Mass, the General Secretary of The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine, Mr. Rafi Ghattas, gave a speech in which he presented the most important achievements of the General Secretary during the past two years, then addressed his words to His Beatitude the Patriarch, saying:

"Young people are not the future, but the present of the Church today, and they alone will determine the future of the Church in Palestine." He asked the Patriarch to rely on the Youth of Jesus' Homeland and to give them a real role in the Church. The mass ended with the announcement of the verse of the year derived from the words of the angel to Saint Joseph, who said to him: "Get up, do not be afraid," in line with the declaration of the Supreme Pontiff to dedicate this year to Saint Joseph the righteous.

Before the Holy Mass, the Patriarch met with the members of The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine. In the meeting, the General secretariat fully explained its role, work and structure. In turn, the Patriarch expressed his admiration and praised the work of the General Secretariat in Palestine, stressing that this meeting is just the beginning of meetings dedicated to young people in the near future. During the discussion that took place between the members of the General Secretariat and His Beatitude, he indicated that the church sometimes talks about matters far from the youth, while the Christian youth in Palestine is the one that touches the reality of the local youth, stressing: "YJHP is the link between the Church and Christian youth in Palestine." He added: "Today we need leaders from the secular youth to be present in all aspects of the church. They are













the ones who touch the reality of the youth." He added: "The church does not consist of consecrated persons and clergy only, but they are here to serve the parish and together they form the church and youth are the living pulse of this church."

After the Holy Mass, His Beatitude, the Patriarch met with the members of YJHP and its committees, who presented him with a summary of the most prominent challenges and problems facing Christian youth in Palestine, and presented their most prominent demands and opinions on solutions, and its implementation despite all the obstacles, especially those related to the Israeli occupation, stressing that: "Christian youth have the right to live in dignity and freedom, and they must obtain their rights in various ways. He also said: "The Church bears its responsibility towards youth and families, as it always works to create possible opportunities and provide needs." Spiritual and materialistic for all the children of its parishes, but the church will not be able to provide all the needs alone, but the youth of the church must provide aid and initiatives for the success of the church's work in society." After the meeting with His Beatitude ended, they had lunch with all the members, and after that, the General Secretariat for Christian Youth in Palestine completed its internal work to prepare for the rest of the 2021 activities, especially the Lent activities.

The next day, on February 27, the General Secretariat met with Fr. Jamal Daibes and then with Mr. Maghnam Ghannam to discuss the strategies that the General Secretariat will work on and follow in its next work.

ANNUAL ACTIVITIES

Lent Activities



The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine annually organizes activities during Lent for all groups (Children, Elementary, Secondary, University, and Workers), but this year because of the spread of the pandemic, Lent Activities this year were limited to university and working groups.

➤ University Group

On April 16, 2021, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland-Palestine" held an activity for the university group on foot in Wadi Qana near the village of Deir Istiya. The activity was titled "Now is the time," which aims to live the experience of the saints through the experiences they went through. These experiences motivate young people to face the challenges they face, by relying on the Lord without fear, because it is time for us to allow the hand of the Lord to touch our lives and heal us. Where 120 young men and boys from different parishes participated in this activity.



The activity began with the Holy Mass, which was presided over by Fr. Remon Haddad, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, and the Deacon Wajdi Shawahneh. The General Chaplain of the General Secretariat, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, said in his sermon: "Now is the time for us to live in the present moment and to leave what is behind us and move forward, and we have to open







our hearts so that the love of God grows in it and to let it be reflected in our relationship with others.

Then the route started with the tour guide, Saed Shomali, and the university committee, who organized five different stations during the route focused on identifying the lives of some saints and the difficulties they faced and how they faced them.

It included discussions and sharing of life experiences, with meditative pauses between the distinctive Palestinian nature. Deacon Wajdi Sahawneh, Deacon Ramez Twal, Deacon Louis Suleiman and Deacon Nadim Giacaman participated in exchanging with the youth their spiritual experiences and some challenges they went through and are still in their lives towards the priesthood. At the end, the leader of the university committee summarized all the ideas of the activity and linked it to the life of Saint Joseph, the righteous one, to whom the youth is dedicated this year, in line with the announcement of His Holiness Pope Francis at the beginning of this year.

➤ Workers Group

On April 9, 2021, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland-Palestine" held for the first time after the spread of the Coronavirus, an activity for the working group on foot from the shrine of the Prophet Musa to Ain Al-Fashkha, and it was titled "Hand in Hand", with the participation of nearly 80 young people and boys from different parishes.

The activity began with a welcome speech and some ice breaking games in the parish of The Good Shepherd - Jericho. Then everyone celebrated the Holy Mass, which was presided over by the General Chaplain of YJHP, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, and the General Chaplain assistant, Fr. Remon Haddad. In the sermon, the General Chaplain addressed the youth, saying: "We have an inner blessing, and it is the kingdom of God implanted within us, and this can be lived by getting to know Jesus, who walks with us "hand in hand" despite the difficulties, diseases, trials and epidemics we face. To be responsible for my freedom and to make God's presence active in society and the world."

During the activity, there were discussions, in which the participants participated in their life experiences and the challenges they face, especially in the labour market. Then, the General Secretary Rafi Ghattas addressed a speech to the participants, stressing that the role of Christian youth should not be confined to the corridors of the church and its institutions only, but the most important role lies outside it, within society with all its spectrums, for Christian youth to live the true meaning of the salt of the earth and to be true witnesses in Jesus' Homeland.

Then the youth lived a unique experience with Christ by walking and reading the stations of the cross in the middle of the desert. Christ walked through hardships and difficulties to reach Mount Calvary. The activity ended with the end of the path down from the Dead Sea overlooking the area to Al-Fakhsha area, to end the meeting in the Latin Monastery of Jericho.








ANNUAL ACTIVITIES

Summer Camps and Activities



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> Children Group

n Sep. 10, 2021, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland-Palestine" held an activity for children entitled "Shipment of Love" that held in the Church of the Redeemer - Taybeh, which bears the verse "There is no greater love than this: that a person sacrifices himself for the sake of his loved ones" and where About 120 participants participated in it.

The activity began with a Holy mass presided over by the General Chaplain, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, and the General Chaplain Assistant, Fr. Remon Haddad. Fr. Bashar indicated that we always need love in our lives and that the most appropriate place to fill our hearts with love is Jesus Christ; The place where love springs. After that, the participants were divided into two groups that included games on puffers, and part with Sister Mona Totah, in which she touched on the story of the birth of the Virgin Mary and her life with her parents.

The program included various games and challenges among the parishes, in which the parish of Ramallah deservedly won. The meeting ended with the celebration of the birthday of the Virgin Mary, which falls on the eighth of September. Through the celebration, the children released helium balloons towards the sky, carrying their requests and messages to the Mother of God, the Virgin Mary, who gave us her love, Our beloved Saviour, who himself loved her to the most.













➤ Elementary Group

n August 27, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine held a for the elementary group at the Church of the Virgin, Sultana Al-Salam - Birzeit that entitled "You can get in my heart" with the participation of 130 participants. The activity began with the Holy mass, which was presided over by Fr. Louis Salman, with the participation of Fr. Nadim Giacaman, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh and Fr. Remon Haddad. He explained in his sermon the importance and benefit of having Jesus in our hearts, and in order to get him in our hearts we must be: "Most humble children, and we must show the love of Jesus present in my heart, as the preparatory instructed: "We are witnesses of Christ, and messengers of him, and we must bear fruit for him, for when we sow love, we shall reap love."

Later, a court was held in which the accused of Satan was the cartoon character Zaytoun, and he was accused of the following charges: Freedom; It is inanimate and not free - time; His time is not devoted to God - friendships; bad friends - sin; He is a sinner, how should he be close to God? Sister Shatha Haddadin shared with us how to understand and live with these charges that we can live with today; she said that "everything has a time, and every matter under heaven has a time", and that sin keeps us away from the heart of Jesus, but that does not mean surrender, but "in weakness lies strength". God strengthens us in the midst of our problems, and therefore we must keep Jesus in our heart, and choose distinguished friends to

walk with in our relationship with God. Then the participants were divided into teams to participate in various paragraphs represented by religious, cultural, and entertainment information. The meeting ended with a games part, and in the end, Zeitoun and Sister Shatha emphasised that our hearts remain open to Jesus and that we are always ready to live joyfully with Him.

➤ Secondary Group

n Sep 12, The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland" held its last summer activity for a secondary group entitled "60 minutes", which was held at Christ the Redeemer Parish - Taybeh, where nearly 180 participants from various parishes participated. The activity started with the gathering of the participants and playing some icebreakers so that participants from parishes engage with each other. Then, Ms. Yara Zayed presented a meeting aimed at regulating the time of the youth in secondary school, and the challenges they face in the age of internet and peer pressure. After that, participants were divided into teams for a bible competition in which teams were tested on their knowledge of the bible.

At midday, everyone participated in the Holy Mass that was presided over by the Vice of the General Chaplain of the youth, Fr. Remon Haddad, and Fr. Nadeem Giacaman. This was followed by a spiritual meeting with the General Chaplain, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh titled "No Filter" where he spoke about the tough challenges that the Christian youth at their age experience in this world and he gave his advice on how to face them.













After lunch, participants were divided into parishes to play games and each parish competed against the other in a fun and playful atmosphere followed by a small meditation and a thanks to God for all his blessings and gifts that he has granted us. At the end of the day, small gifts were handed out as a memory of this day.

➤ University Group

n August 4, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus' Homeland" set up its camp for the university group "My Faith x 7", which lasted for 4 days in The Cremisan Monastery – Bethlehem, where nearly 80 participants from various parishes participated. The camp dealt with the subject of the sacrament in detail and touched upon how the Christian youth live these sacraments in their lives and persevere in this Christian faith. The camp began with the Holy Mass, which was presided over by Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, who spoke in his sermon about the importance of the sacrament in our lives and how to work with them. The committee was able to get the camp's goal through meetings and panel discussions on some verses from the Holy Bible and evenings that took place in the "Taizé" manner.

During the camp, the General Secretariat hosted Mrs. Nelly Faddoul a trainer certified by the International Board in Human Development - who began her meeting with a contemplative spiritual and then began her talk with a meeting to enable young people to know and appreciate themselves, in addition to their view of values and beliefs and their impact on life outcomes, and shed light on Highlight their

roles in life and know their mission and goal to achieve happiness. Then the participants visited the winery to learn more about the monastery.

The General Secretariat also hosted the deacon Ibrahime Bolus in this camp to hear the life experiences that the youth lived in the camp. During this meeting, he held panel discussions to discuss life matters and priorities in our lives and evaluation moments for the camp. Finally, the camp ended with a Holy mass presided over by Fr. Bashar Fawadleh and he ended his sermon with the phrase "My Faith" x 7 = I am a believer and a student." At the end of his speech, he thanked the participants for the commitment and the university committee for the effort expended in the camp, asking God to reap the fruits of this camp in their daily lives.

➤ Workers Group

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus" Homeland" held its first camp for workers in the Cremisan Monastery – Beit Jala for 4 days from 20 to 23 July, entitled "Now to Where?" with the participation of more than 70 participants from all the parishes of Jesus' Homeland."Hala Lewin" camp aims to guide the young man and develop the spirit of faith in him. The camp began with the Divine Liturgy, which was presided over by the spiritual guide, Father Bashar Fawadleh, who, in his sermon, linked the idea of immigration with the twelfth chapter of Genesis in the story of God's call to Abraham. Then, Deacon Abdullah gave a simple introduction to the idea of the camp for this year. During the camp, the idea of the camp was explained through meetings and evenings in the life of the Virgin Mary, who faced difficulties, but she was confident in God's will, and also through













the hours of prostration, and panels that revolve around our reality and current conditions, in addition to panel discussions on several topics, including abortion, uterine lending, embryo transplantation, sex determination, euthanasia and many other topics presented by Deacon Abdallah Dababneh. In this camp, the General Secretariat hosted Mr. Joseph Hazboun, Director of the Pontifical Mission Office in Jerusalem, gave a lecture entitled "Our History in Palestine", pointing out the importance of our presence in this land and the importance of proving our presence in this land. General Secretary Rafi Ghattas also presented a panel discussion entitled "Rebellious and Christian", stressing also the importance of our presence. Later, Mrs. Nelly Abu Aita shared with us her life experience through which she sent positive energy, joy and hope in us and said: "We must not choose while we are afraid, we must choose with love."

Mrs. Journa Kaplanian talked about love and self-esteem, up to the topic of "My Relationship with God" presented by Sister Maryam Baabish through meditation on the Bible. On the last day, Father Issa Thaliya gave a meeting about love and religion. The camp ended with a Holy Mass presided over by Father Bashar Fawadleh, where he focused his sermon on: "Our relationship with the Lord "Now to Where" is always joy, and the living Jesus is the source of our joy" and with every pain there is new joy, new hope "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!"(Philippians 4:4) And so the camp ended with the question, "Now To Where?" Now is the time for joy, for love, for trust that God's hands are with us in every time and place and that His will is stronger than human will.

CHRIST THE KING EVENTS



Children Group

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine, "The Youth of Jesus' Homeland" celebrated the Feast of Jesus the King for the Children Group entitled "The Kingdom's Ambassador" on November 5, 2021 at the Church of the Good Shepherd - Jericho. The celebration began with the arrival of the participants and the receipt of the passports of the "Jesus' Homeland Country Palestine" for the celebration of this day, and after entering the "Jesus' Homeland International Airport," the more than 350 participants from all parishes were divided into several teams, each with the name of its own Gate. Then, after preparing to travel, "the planes took off" towards different countries and the children entered the Terra Sancta school building to roam between the classes, which was in each classroom the embodiment of a different country.









During their visit to the countries, two things were focused on, the first is the features of this country and its connection to Christian history, and the second is a detailed explanation of the Holy Mass, including its significance and stages, and all the details related to the establishment of the Divine Sacrifice. At the end of the visit in each country, the participants would go to stamp their passports and stick the flag and some of the country's landmarks on the passport that was made specially for this trip.



After completing all the journeys and returning everyone to the land of "Jesus Homeland International Airport", everyone ate lunch, and then the last flight took off.

The audience sat on the plane seats and fastened their belts, then the last trip to travel to the Kingdom began through the play "The Kingdom's Ambassador" starring Rama Shomali, Rafi Ghattas, Boulos Joakim, and Karam Shalian, which revolves around the idea of school students who dream of being ambassadors when they grow up and the journey begins to search for The country that could receive them will eventually reach them with an invitation from a kingdom "not of this world" asking them to be ambassadors for it, so they conclude that it is a personal invitation from Jesus the King and they answer the call. This trip ended with a special show with the clowns Sesame and Zaatar, who in turn talked about the idea of belonging to the Kingdom in a comic and purposeful framework.

Elementary and Secondary Groups

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "The Youth of Jesus' Homeland" celebrated the Feast of Jesus the King for elementary and secondary groups under the title "It Needs Update" on Nov 12, 2021 at Convention Palace in Bethlehem with the participation of more than 900 from all parishes. The celebration opened with the Palestinian national anthem and youth prayer, in addition to a group of hymns. After the reception, the activity began with Sister Mona Totah of the St. Joseph Congregation, who touched on the importance of the presence of Jesus the King in the life of the Christian youth, through whom we can live the kingdom of the Lord of glory in a heavenly way, emphasising what Jesus said about himself: "My kingdom is not of this world." (John 18:36) that when the kingdom turns to serve the people, then lies salvation. The Lord Christ loves us even with our sins, and teaches us that love brings true happiness.

After the introduction with Sister Mona, the humorous play "Hey Siri" started by General Secretary Rafi Ghattas, Cecilia Kajo, and Fadi Touma, which spoke in a humorous way about the children of this generation's attachment to social networking applications, their addiction to them, and their belief that life stops at their personal pages. The plot of the play is the appearance of "Siri" in the form of a girl who discusses the young man about his activity on social networking sites, and in the end,









they pray that the young man needs an "update" in his personal and spiritual life, and this update works through the sacrament of reconciliation with Jesus Christ. After this play, they received the King of Kings Jesus Christ incarnated



within the sacrament of the Eucharist and lived the most sacred moments with the presence of the Eucharist in their midst. Then the Holy Mass began, which was presided over by Fr. Remon Haddad, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, Fr. Khaled Qamar and Fr. Nadim Giacaman. Fr. Bashar's sermon focused on the importance of the presence and renewal of four elements in our Christian life, namely baptism, prayer, love, and tolerance, through which the Christian youth can make Jesus live in his heart and walk with him towards monarchy.

At the end of the Holy Mass, Mr. Rafi Ghattas, gave a speech in which he focused on the importance of the youth presence in the church and directed his words to the elementary and secondary groups: "You are our youth's army and the fuel of our continuity. After lunch, Mrs. Sherihan Al-Hadwa was a guest on the stage to share in a humorous way her experience of living blind in our society, inspired by the verse of the year for Christian youth: "Get up, do not be afraid." In the end, the celebration ended with the artist Amjad Khair amid a great interaction from the participants.

University and Workers Groups

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine celebrated the feast of Jesus the King for both university and workers groups, entitled "Christ on Board" on Nov 19, 2021. This celebration started from Terra Sancta School in Bethlehem, where 600 participants of the youth gathered from all the homeland of Jesus Palestine, from Galilee and the Middle to Jerusalem and the West Bank, and they began to energise by dancing on YJHP's hymns, then the audience was divided into several groups, and the panel discussions revolved around some verses from the Bible that simulate the youth and their relationship and association with Jesus and His Holy Church. Then, all the participants went to the Church of St. Catherine to celebrate the Holy Mass, which was presided over by His Beatitude Patriarch Pierbattista Pizzaballa, whose Beatitude appointed the members of the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine, after accepting the resignation of the previous secretariat, which served for three years.









In the decree, which was read by the spiritual guide of the youth, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, during the Ceremonial Mass in the Church of the Nativity, His Beatitude announced that Mrs. Nadine Bitar Abu Sahliah will serve as General Secretary and Miss Caroline Diab will be The Vice General Secretary for the next session, which will last for 3 years. This ceremonial mass, which was presided over



by His Beatitude the Patriarch, accompanied by His Eminence Bishop William Shomali, His Eminence Bishop Paul Marketsso, and a group of priests and deacons, was attended by about 600 young men and women from all of historic Palestine. In his sermon, His Beatitude the Patriarch said that this youth gathering, whose main goal is Jesus Christ, makes us proud of the church's youth, adding: "We have to be affiliated, responsible, and committed to Jesus Christ, the Church, and others, so that our service is stable and not fleeting, so that we can truly live the kingdom of Christ on earth." His Beatitude also thanked what was presented by the previous General Secretariat, especially during the pandemic, saying: "This work of yours was a consolation to me, and this work must continue and grow, as it encourages us adults and gives us a boost of hope and energy, which makes you learn in

pastoral work because The Christian way of appearing, and shining is to serve with humility and love." After the Holy Mass in the Church of the Nativity ended, everyone went to the Conference Palace to complete the activity with great joy. There, the resigned General Secretary Rafi Ghattas announced the launch of the new website of the General Secretariat and added that the Youth Application (YJHP) would soon be launched and would be available on all mobile devices.

Then, Mr. Rafi Ghattas officially announced the end of the role of the General Secretariat in its current session and officially handed over the service of the position of General Secretary to Mrs. Nadine Bitar Abu Sahliah, who in turn gave a speech in which she thanked all the former members and spoke about her experience and ambitions that the General Secretariat for Christian Youth in Palestine would like to achieve. She sent a message to all the participants and told them: "Be strong with every experience you cross and create a message from it."

Then the daughter of the youth, Ronza Halawa, shared the experience of her victory over cancer, which she was able to overcome despite all the obstacles. She said: "Be strong in every experience you cross and create a message from it." She talked about how she went through an experience while she adhered to Christ and recalled the life of the apostles who adhered to the gospel and the message despite all the difficulties they faced at the time. She added that the disease made her realize the true blessings that Jesus the King gave her, which in turn made her triumph over this malignant disease. The celebration reached its peak on the stage of the Conferences Palace with the play, where it spoke about a ship abandoned by the captain and gave













the helm of leadership to those on it, promising them that he would come back. When they started to compete for leadership, then things started to become clear to the viewers in a humorous way, so the play talks about the division between the Eastern and Western Church and its consequences for the life of the ship, which represents the role of the Church. Then the Doban Dance Troupe from Jerusalem presented an amazing performance in which they presented dances that expressed the human diversity that the city of Jerusalem embraced hundreds of years ago. It is mentioned that these dances are part of the "Salal" show. The central celebration was ended when all members of the former and current General Secretariat came on the stage, participating in the hymns of the youth of YJHP, and they threw a large globe among the participants, which was moving on the grandstand among all the youth members, in an indication that the Christian youth can move the world and affect it through its service, its presence and its faith.

During the meeting, His Beatitude Patriarch Pierbattista Pizzaballa appointed the members of the Secretariat of the General Secretary of Christian Youth in Palestine after accepting the resignation of the previous secretariat, which served for three years, represented

by its General Secretary, Mr. Rafi Ghattas, and his Vice General Secretary, Ms. Mira Khader, Then, His Beatitude announced in the decree that the General Chaplain of the General Secretariat, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, read during the ceremonial mass in the Church of Nativity, that Mrs. Nadine Bitar Abu Sahliah will serve as General Secretary and Miss Caroline Diab will be Vice General Secretary for the next three years. At the end of the mass, the resigned General Secretary, Rafi Ghattas, gave a word of thanks in which he focused on the importance of work and volunteering within the church field, especially in the youth, and said:

rirst of all, I thank the Lord Jesus Christ, who gave us the opportunity to gather in this holy place, this place that witnessed the birth of salvation for the entire world. Exactly three years ago, I received an official decision from His Beatitude the Patriarch to appoint me as a General Secretary of The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "Youth of Jesus" Homeland". At first glance, the decision was difficult, I was still in the fourth year of university, and I had plans and projects like any student at the door of graduation, and the question I asked myself was: Why me and why now? I am at a crossroads in practical and academic life, so why this choice? And between hesitation and confusion, the Bible was my answer, and I was then able to understand that God's call to his humble servant, I accepted and


After its completion, the winners of the competition were announced. Zain Khouryeh won first place, three people won



n March 6, 2021 at eight o'clock in the evening, The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine organised a special meeting via social media with Fr. Issa Hijazin, priest of Our Lady of Fatima Parish -Beit Sahour, and the Bible teacher at Latin Patriarchal Seminary. In this zoom meeting, he talked about the Gospel of St. Mark. During this valuable meeting, many questions were answered: Who is Saint Mark? What was his role in the early church? When did he write his gospel and why? What distinguishes the Gospel of St. Mark from others? How do we read the Bible correctly and how do we meditate on its texts? Fr. Issa Hijazin distinguished himself in his answers to these questions, besides to some questions posed by participants and viewers.



➤ Evening with Saint Joseph

n March 19, on the occasion of the feast of Saint Joseph, The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine celebrated it through an evening of prayer via social media from the Church of Our Lady of Fatima - Beit Sahour, in the presence of Sister Mona Totah, one of the sisters of Saint Joseph, to talk also about her life experience.

It began with prayers and requests raised by Mr. Charlie Batarseh, Prayer Committee leader. A short video was shown linking our life, which is full of challenges and difficulties, to the life of Saint Joseph, which was not without difficulties as well. Sometimes we try to escape from reality because of the difficulties in our lives. Although running away one day we will find that it will not be the solution and sometimes we forget that Christ told us, "Our life





on this earth is full of challenges, and we will not reach the kingdom unless we carry the cross and enter through the narrow road." Many saints lived through these confusions, including Saint Joseph." St. Joseph was a modest and righteous carpenter, but he too lived in great confusion when he found out about his pregnant fiancée, but he heard the Lord's voice, understood the truth, believed, and took up his cross. Saint Joseph chose the difficult path, so he chose to emigrate and escape. He chose fatigue and instability for the sake of God, but in return God gave him the grace to be a father to the Lord of lords and a good husband to the mother of all the world. We must always remember the life of Saint Joseph, every time we fall into distress or fear, and remember God's words that tell us, "Rise, and do not be afraid."

Then, Mr. Charlie Batarseh spoke about the slogan of The Youth of Jesus' Homeland for 2021: "Rise. and do not be afraid," which the angel said to St. Joseph in the dream is scattered in the Bible. First, in the first chapter in the Gospel of Saint Matthew, when he said to him, do not be afraid to bring your wife to your house. And in the second chapter, when he said to him, "Get up and take the child and his mother from here to Egypt, and once from

Egypt to here after the death of Herod the Great." And then talked about the importance of these words in our reality today. These words do not expire as if they are an eternal message to us.

Then Sister Mona Totah talked about her life experience. At the beginning, she said, "My life is like the life of any young girl and boy who go through moments of confusion and difficulties, and moments of strength and courage in their lives." After that, Sister Mona Totah spoke about her family, who raised her in faith, and about the Saint Joseph school, from which she learned the meaning of faith. "Honestly, I never thought I would ever become a sister," she said. After I finished my school studies, she said, I entered Bethlehem University to study child rearing. She said that the sentence "Get up, do not be afraid" had an echo in my life. It was the first time I heard it from Sister Mary, one of the sisters of Saint Joseph, who handled me in my childhood. She said, "When I was young, I had a problem finding friends, and this sister always said to me: "Get up!" O Mona, do not be afraid, I am with you." And she said, I always felt empty inside. After all the prayer journey that I went through and my service in the church, and the many signs that touched my life from people, a book, and a dream. Then I discovered that my true calling was to be a sister. After that, I left everything behind me and acted like St. Joseph heard the voice of the angel telling me to get up and do not be afraid. After 14 years in monastic life, I still hear the Lord saying to me: "Get Up, do not be afraid."

And she ended her speech by sending a message to the youth of Jesus' homeland, saying: "Jesus asks you today to Get Up and to Not Be Afraid. You are the future of the homeland of Jesus, and you have to build my trust."

The evening ended in a short video that continued what Sister Mona Totah started talking about, it talks about the opinion of the saints about Saint Joseph.

↑ s every year, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine participated in Palm Sunday in Jerusalem. The General Secretary of the Christian Youth in Palestine, "The Youth of Jesus' Homeland," Mr. Rafi Ghattas, gave a speech in the presence of His Beatitude Patriarch Pizzaballa, the Apostolic Nuncio, the Franciscan Custos of the Holy Land, and a group of priests and monks with the faithful prior to start the traditional religious procession from Beit Faji in Jerusalem.

During his speech, he said, "Before, more than two thousand years ago, Christ came with his few followers and wanted to enter this holy city. The people of this city welcomed him with a great celebration. They cheered him, praised the God of Zion, and threw their clothes on the ground to bless it as he passed over it. Their number was few, they did not come from all over the world, Some of them came from all over Palestine, but most of the attendees were from here, from this city in particular, the city of Jerusalem!



And today is just like that time!

Here we are today, circumstances decided that the country would not receive many pilgrims from all over the world to welcome their Christ inside the Holy City, but here we are the sons of Jerusalem. the grandchildren of those who received Christ two thousand years ago, we repeat the same tradition with a youthful spirit and raise our olives and palms high to welcome the Lord of lords, Jesus Christ in our Jerusalem, our country, and our hearts, and we will be the first witnesses next week to his resurrection from the dead.

This special occasion and these current circumstances in particular makes us remember that Christ came here, to our land alone, our Almighty God embodied in our country and walked in it, preached, and taught, then completed his mission in

We pray to our Almighty Father to gather all the believers from everywhere next year, let us celebrate Palm Sunday and continue our journey towards the resurrection of our beloved Saviour.

My dear brothers and sisters, more than two thousand years after the entry of Christ, here we are, the children of Jerusalem, we are back again to be the only ones who welcome Him as in the first time. To be Palestinians, walking in the footsteps of Christ in the same paths he took and smelling the scent of his fragrance in our country, let us always remember that we are the true guardians of this city! Let's stay here and raise the olive branches that remind us of our solid roots in this earth and let us glorify the Holy Name in the highest and let us say together with the fullness of our hearts while we are filled with the Holy Spirit who descended on the Apostles in Cenacle to say: "Hosanna! Hosanna to the Son of David. Hosanna! Hosanna to the King of Kings."

➤ And it is Time to Evolve, Change

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine "The Youth of Jesus' Homeland - Palestine" always looks forward to developing its youth in all possible ways. It believes in Christian youth to continue its mission in the coming years. In light of this subject, the Coordination and Development Committee in the General Secretariat saw the urgent need to work first with the youth leaders for all the committees and its members, so it organised a development program for one day for each committee according to their needs with the aim of enabling the committee members to provide a better Christian service within the youth and their parishes.



The first development meeting was held on April 10, 2021, with the Prayer Committee through Zoom app due to the Corona pandemic. The Prayer Committee asked to learn more about the Church's leadership and responsibilities and accordingly Mrs. Nadine Bitar-Abu Sahliah, who works at the Christian Education Office of the Latin Patriarchate, met the Committee for two hours, they talked in this meeting about the Church leadership and the role of the laity in improving our churches.

On April 17, 2021, the Elementary and Secondary committees met

together in an intensive one-day meeting in Holy Family Catholic Church, Ramallah, with Mrs. Laila Daibes, an expert in adolescent affairs, in adolescent psychology and way of thinking in addition to how to deal with adolescents and social counselling, as adolescence is a sensitive age to deal with them in general and especially when it comes to Christian service, many face different forms of changes in their daily life and routine, for this reason; It was important to help our leaders learn more about adolescent psychology and discover new and innovative ways to work with them.

As for the university and working committees, we always notice, through the various meetings with the youth, the conflicts that young people suffer when it comes to the Christian faith. Many of them do not understand the foundations of our true faith. On April 23, 2021, an intensive four-hour meeting was held for these committee members in Holy Family Catholic Church, Ramallah. The meeting dealt with discussions on "Biblical teachings and the doctrine of the Holy Trinity" with Fr. Bernard Boge, the head of Latin Patriarchal Seminary. As for the second part of the meeting, Dr. Estephan Salameh, advisor to the Prime Minister of Palestine, was a guest lecturer in a distinguished meeting with the committees to talk about his personal experience in "preserving our Christian faith in social and civil institutions: healthy lifestyles."

As for the Children Group, which is considered the largest in the Christian youth in Palestine, and because the General Secretariat believes that this category will help in building its future, their













presence is essential for Christian services for the coming years. Therefore, the Children Committee met on May 7, 2021, at Holy Family Catholic Church, Ramallah, with Ms. Sandy Totah, an expert in children's affairs, on "Child Psychology and Self-Confidence" to help leaders better understand children and work with them according to their age. The committee also met with Sister Mona Totah, one of the Sisters of Saint Joseph, to learn more about communicating God's word to children through "Bible Games"

And certainly, there was the same for the Coordination and Development Committee. On June 4, 2021, at Holy Family Catholic Church, Ramallah, they met with Mr. Omar Harami of the Sabeel Center for Palestinian Liberation Theology, to learn about "creative thinking", to help committee members to create new programs and support the ideas of other committees. Because of the difficult tasks entrusted to this committee during the various activities, they sometimes miss the spiritual aspect of the secretariat services. Therefore, they also met with Fr. Salem Lolas, one of the priests of the Latin Patriarchate, to talk about the importance of their logistical work to serve the youth and its positive impact on our youth.

These programs are essential to all Secretariat's committees, as they help keep youth services delivered in a vibrant and productive manner. The General Secretariat seeks to develop and invest in people instead of buildings. It invests in its leaders to maintain the continuity of its services and to preserve God's word and work throughout the youth of Jesus' Homeland program.

➤ Helping Youth To Create Their Future **Scholarships**

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth - Palestine always provides assistance to its youth in order to survive in the land and help them flourish. As part of the efforts made by the Latin Patriarchate in Jerusalem to provide everything it can for its youth, it provided the Jesus' Homeland University Scholarship through the General Secretariat, Christ the King Bookstore, and with the support of several institutions that support youth pastoral work. The Jesus' Homeland Scholarship was offered twice during the year to the committed youth in the parishes. who always work to serve and help the parishes in its role. The youth are the cornerstone of Christian parishes, and they are the cornerstone of the service provided by the youth of Jesus' Homeland. In offering this scholarship, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth - Palestine wanted to offer them a reward for everything they do in order to thank them, strengthen their affiliation, and in order to encourage them to learn and study, which also plays a major role in their prosperity.

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine presented the first one in February, targeting all Christian youth in Palestinian universities, and priority was given to students affected by the Corona pandemic. The number of students who benefited from this scholarship was 28 students from different universities.






➤ For You We Pray Episode

n May 15, the memory of the Nakba for 73 years, On the occasion of that fateful day, and from the city of Jerusalem, from the heart of the holy city, for Palestine, Jesus' Home-Land, and for the city of prayer the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine held, through the General Secretariat's Facebook page and on Noursat TV, a special episode, entitled "For You, We Pray", presented by Secretary General Rafi Ghattas.

Mr. Rafi Ghattas started the episode by talking and linking the torment, pain and killing of Jesus in this city two thousand years ago, who despite all of this did not escape and continued his journey until death to reach the resurrection after that. Thus, we are the sons of Palestine, since 73 years ago, we have been walking with Christ on the path of His suffering, bearing the cross of pain and the cross of occupation, but we are confident that after this pain and struggle we will reach the Resurrection.

The episode continued with songs and hymns with the voice of the chanter Maroun Helou, who was hosted by the General Secretariat in the episode, followed by the reading of the evangelical text





from the Gospel of Saint Luke by Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, who then mentioned important and historical events that occurred in this city and about the connection of Christ with his homeland and land.

The General Secretary of Christian Youth in Palestine hosted Fr. Jamal Khader, General Secretary for christian Institutions in Palestine and Priest of Ramallah Parish, was hosted to answer some questions. What is our role under these difficult circumstances? And how can we live the teachings of Christ

in the midst of all we suffer from injustice, occupation and pain. After answering these question and during the episode, they discussed the importance of Jerusalem for all of us as Christians, the position of Christians as a minority within this city and their affiliation with this holy place, the Antichrist for the Christian Zionists who are rejected by most churches, and many topics that emphasise the importance of the Christian presence and its religious and historical connection in this City. During that, a report prepared by the General Secretariat in Jerusalem was presented about the Christian presence in this land in the homeland of Jesus and about their roots that are here and that will never know surrender so that Christ remains alive in us. After commenting on the report, and at the end of the episode, the father sent a message to Palestinians in Gaza who are suffering and said to them, "We are with you." He also greeted every Palestinian and told them to stay in this land, to build a better future, to teach our children about this city and the importance of our presence here Then the episode was concluded with a speech from Mr. Rafi Ghattas, and Fr. Bashar Fawadleh offered a prayer for the Lady of Palestine, and at the end a part of hymns and songs.

➤ Coming to you Episode

oinciding with the end of the Virgin Mary month, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine held an episode entitled "Coming To You" for the children and elementary groups on May 29, where the episode was broadcast on social media sites in addition to Orient Channel. The episode started with a welcome from the leader of the elementary committee, Rasha Odeh, explaining the purpose of the episode. Where the first part of the episode aimed



to talk about the life of the Virgin Mary, who lived and glorified in the homeland of Jesus, and in the second part there were many challenges and competitions that were answered by calling the number that was displayed on the screen or participating by answering the episode question that was at the bottom of the screen "Where was the Virgin Mary born?"

In the first part of the episode, a video was shown of a member of the elementary committee, Maysan Zahran, who filmed it in the places where our Mother Mary lived, talking about the life of the Virgin Mary, Our mother, the Virgin Mary, is like any Palestinian child born in Palestine. It started in the city of Nazareth, the city of the Annunciation. The city of Nazareth is the city in which the Virgin Mary participated in salvation. Then she moved to the village of Ein Karem, where the angel announced the Virgin Mary with Elizabeth's rope, and our mother Mary was happy with this news. Then she moved to Bethlehem to talk about the Church of the Nativity, the place where Jesus Christ was born. Then, talked about the cave of milk that turned white because of a drop of milk from the Virgin Mary when she was breastfeeding her son, the baby Jesus, and then she talked about the miracles that the Virgin Mary accompanied to Christ with. The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine launched its website "Yjhp.ps" on November 19, 202. The website was developed by the Website Administrator Mr. Paul Youwakim during 2021. ➤ Research Study in coordination with Juhoud

n partnership with the Pontifical Mission in Jerusalem and in cooperation with the General Secretariat of Christian Youth - Palestine and the Christian Education Office of the Latin Patriarchate, Juhoud for Community and Rural Development carried out a study entitled "The Reality, Concerns and Needs of Christian Youth", which targeted Christian gatherings in the West Bank, Jerusalem, and Gaza. This study is one of the most important contemporary and recent studies carried out on the needs and interests of Christian youth in a holistic manner, which aimed:

- Knowing the needs and reality of Christian youth in order to design programs that suit their needs and aspirations.
- 2 Determining their interests in development projects, which include economic and social empowerment projects, employment, small projects, awareness-raising, training and community leadership, and ways to encourage them to participate and benefit from these projects.
- 3 Determining the challenges and difficulties facing Christian youth.
- **4** Determining the topics that young people need in quidance, counselling, Christian education and Christian youth leadership.

Focused meetings with young men and women groups were carried out in 16 gatherings in the West Bank, Jerusalem and the Gaza Strip within the following criteria:



The age group should be between 18-35 years and not be limited or focused on a specific age group, as it was preferable that each group includes university students, employees or business owners, representatives of youth clubs, scout teams, active women's centres in gatherings, and those who are interested.

In addition, to confirm the qualitative and quantitative information, 12 meetings were held with representatives of institutions and legal persons to confirm the results and hold them accountable about the Christian reality, its challenges and future aspirations.



The meetings included asking a number of guiding questions that help in motivating the participants to answer, so that the following topics and questions are covered:

- The reality of Christian youth from an economic and social perspective.
- Christian identity and belonging.
- Fears and feelings of insecurity.
- Christian education and educational and guidance topics.
- The trends and needs in the various civil and political activities.
- Trends and needs in economic and social development activities.
- Challenges facing youth and available opportunities.

In addition to focus groups with young people, answers (quantitative survey) were collected and analysed with 350 samples by distributing a questionnaire to more than 800 young men and women in all regions with the aim of filling it out, and the questionnaire was filled out electronically (online survey) through social media (Facebook Messenger) while ensuring equal distribution between males and females, and this information was treated with strict confidentiality only for the purposes of the study by the advisory team and institutions supervising the study.

➤ 1 Never Die, 1 Enter Life -Fr. Toufiq Buhedar-

Caint Therese of the Child Jesus, the patron saint of Father Monsignor Tawfiq Bou Hader, was repeating: "I never die, but I enter life." And here is Father Tawfig entering eternal life on the 19th of October, the day of the anniversary of the announcement of his patron saint as a tutor in the Universal Church. Fr. Tawfig spread the love of giving in the youth's heart, in addition to the love, joy and hope in every person he met, anywhere in the world. He is one of the founders of the congregation "Jesus is my Joy" in Lebanon, the founder of the Youth Pastoral Office in the Maronite Patriarchal Department and its supervisor since 2011. Our father Tawfig worked hard on his Christian mission wherever he was. He built bridges between the youth of Lebanon and the world, and he worked to build strong friendship and close cooperation with the Youth of Jesus' Homeland in Palestine. He was the main motivator, guide, leader and servant of the youth and taught us to love the youth and to be the heart of the Church, which must always beat and remain young.

Fr. Tawfig dreamed of visiting the land of Jesus' homeland, the land of Palestine, and he repeatedly expressed his desire to visit the places where Jesus taught, preached and performed miracles. He also expressed his desire to ascend the Mount of Calvary to walk with Christ towards the Holy Sepulchre and carry his light into his hands. However, God's call was earlier than the end of the occupation, so he passed away to the heavenly throne, placing whomever he loved in the Father's hands.



During the year 2020, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine worked with Monsignor Tawfig on the "From Jerusalem, Peace to Beirut" initiative, after the great explosion that shook the Lebanese capital and shook the hearts of everyone. The youth of Jesus's homeland were able to provide moral and material support to about 30 families through father Tawfig.

Today, after we bid farewell to our beloved monsignor, we turn our eyes upward from everywhere in the homeland of Jesus, and say: "From Jerusalem, peace to heaven."

Peace to the one who loved the youth, believed in its mission, made youth his first and last concern and devoted his whole life to spreading the word of Christ in their hearts. He deserved to be told to him: 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'(Mathew 25:23).



➤ Strategic Plan

This three years strategic plan is considered one of the main milestones that was conducted by the Chaplaincy of the Youth of Jesus' Homeland – Palestine. This strategy includes a response to the Christian youth needs and challenges which emerged during the last years.

Over the years; The General Secretariat of the Chaplaincyof the Youth of Jesus' Homeland has worked to adapt its

interventions with the needs of Palestinian Christian youth and has been striving to meet their various needs. However, it has recently become necessary to work on a long-term plan that adopts updated methods in order to communicate with the reality of Palestinian Christian youth and to respond to the challenges and dramatic changes that have occurred during the last ten years.



This strategic plan was conducted through using a participatory approach that included the youth and priests in the different parishes in addition to mainstreaming the different decision-makers' opinions. The descriptive approach was adopted by conducting focus groups and interviews with many parish priests and youth groups in the parishes, in addition to working closely with members of the General Secretariat.

During the design of this strategy, a challenge emerged, which is the presence of different actors and many studies and statistics on the reality of the Christian community in Palestine, especially the Christian youth, and for this reason one of the difficulties was to repeat the steps of working









with the same groups in the same areas, and therefore the results of other studies were used. Which contributed to documenting information and results and coming up with common results.

Therefore, a compilation of different studies was made to include their results within this strategy such as;

- 1 The study "Survey of Christian Organizations in Palestine: Social and Economic Impact" carried out by the consultant Mr.GeorgeAkroush and funded by the Pontifical Mission and in cooperation with Dar Al-Kalima University in 2021.
- 2 "A community study on the needs, challenges, aspirations and the way forward for Christian youth in Jerusalem" carried out by the Consultant Mr. George Akroush and funded by the Coordination of Catholic Aid Organisations (CCAO) sponsored by the German Association of the Holy Land (DVHL) in the year
- Finally, the study "Analysis of the Reality, Needs, and Interests of Christian Youth in the West Bank, East Jerusalem and the Gaza Strip" which was carried out by the JuhoodFoundation for Community and Rural Development with the assistance of a group of consultants.

The main goals of the strategy are:

- Contribute to spreading the Christian faith by bearing witness to a conscious and mature Christian faith in front of all people.
- 2 Developing the General Secretariat for the Chaplaincy of the Youth of Jesus' Homeland - Palestine by creating a leadership

- generation that bears responsibility In his community, church and family.
- 3 Develop and empower young people in various fields to be role models for future generations.

List of required steps to implement this strategy are:

- To conduct monthly coordination and monthly meetings with the members of the secretariat and follow-up of plans by the coordinator.
- Working to hold coordination meetings with parish priests and asking them to participate in implementing parts of the strategy as described in the plan.
- 3 It is necessary to meet with the patriarch in order to inform him of the results of the strategy and the necessity of hiring a coordinator in the patriarchate for the general secretariat.
- The need to find funding opportunities to complete the work of the strategy and carry over the parts that have not been applied for subsequent years. And the separation of the budget of the library of Jesus the King from the budget of the Secretariat.
- The need to work on developing internal guides, including the administrative manual, the financial manual, the volunteering manual, the media and communication plan, and the code of conduct.
- **6** The necessity of distributing the ta6outh through local coordinators
- The necessity of building the capacities of the members of the secretariat through an intensive training diploma.
- Work on the monitoring and evaluation system by the coordinator of the General Secretariat in order to ensure the implementation of activities on a monthly basis.
- Work must be done to modify the roles and responsibilities in the plan according to what the secretariat deems appropriate and through coordination with the secretariat coordinator.



➤ Last Workshop!

The General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine held its last workshop at the end of its 3-year session, before the start of the celebrations of Christ Jesus the King and the appointment of the new General Secretariat, an intensive workshop was held for members of the secretariat and committees on Thursday and Friday, October 21 and 22, 2021 at Murad Tourist Resort–Beit Sahour. The workshop began with a meeting of the General secretariat members with the current administration represented by the General Secretary Rafi Ghattas and Vice General Secretary Mira Khader,



who confirmed the progress of the general plan to prepare for the upcoming celebrations of Jesus the King to be held at the beginning of November. After the general meeting, all the committees met separately and completed their preparations for the upcoming celebrations. The first day ended with an evening of entertainment for all members of the General Secretariat and its committees. On the second day, the meeting began with Deacon Bob Paul, who gave the youth a lecture entitled "Discipleship on the Methods of Hunting Humans According to the Strategies of Jesus Christ." and he gave an example of one who followed these strategies; the late Monsignor Tawfig Bu Hadeer, who passed away a few days before the workshop was held, had a special relationship between him and the youth of Palestine in pastoral and youth work. At the end of the first part of the second day, all participants celebrated the divine sacrifice on the occasion of the feast of the youth of the saint, Pope John Paul II, which was headed by Father Bashar Fawadleh and Father Remon Haddad. The prayer was offered as a relief to the late Monsignor Tawfig Bou Hadeer. The workshop was completed between the committees to conclude the necessary preparation for the upcoming celebrations.









➤ A Holy Mass on the occasion of Our Lady of Palestine

On the 30th of October, the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine participated in the celebration of "Our Lady of Palestine", the feast of Our Lady of Virgin Mary at Rafat Monastery in Jerusalem, the ceremony in which thousands of Christians from different regions of Palestine were present. The celebration was also held on the occasion of the launch of the first stage of the Ecclesiastical Synod, which was launched by Pope Francis on the nineteenth of the same month in Rome. The Synod aims at spiritual renewal in the Church around the world, under the emblem of "Communion, Participation and Mission."

The mass was presided over by His Beatitude Patriarch Pier Battista Pizzaballa and with Heads of Churches in the Holy Land. His Beatitude spoke in his homily that communion in the Holy Land has several faces: between Christians of different churches, between different monastic groups, and with people of



other faiths and religions. Patriarch Pizzaballa also called for the need to shift from the situation of frustration and despair to the state of joy and hope by being open to others and by caring and listening to them.

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➤ It is Not A Passing Phase!

y journey started when I was 6 years old. I was going to VI the Divine Liturgy every Sunday and immediately after the Liturgy I was always going to the Sunday School. I don't remember ever having missed, and certainly I participated in all the summer camps that had a great impact on my life. Its great impact makes me remember so many situations from it.

And when I became 11 years old, here I started a new stage, the "preparatory group" and the first change was, and after 3 years, I entered the secondary group. During these 6 years, I always helped the nuns with the preparation of the meetings, and I was there before the meeting, and after helping them. I was a very lucky person, because the youth had a great influence in every step of my life and character.

The second change occurred when I entered the university group and became one of those responsible for the preparatory and secondary groups, and here I began to learn how to be responsible in a good manner in order to be influential on the youth in a way that brings them closer to our Lord and the Church, and this has always been my goal.

Certainly, the General Secretariat for Christian Youth, "the Youth of Jesus's Homeland," was an integral part of all these stages that I mentioned. Because the General Secretariat in the past had always done activities, camps and celebrations for Christian youth, and I had always participated in these



activities and camps. There was always something that drew me to these activities, the effect of which would be eternal.

After years of participation and service in the church, the most powerful change in my journey with the Christian youth occurred. It was during a camp for the General Secretariat of Christian Youth - Palestine in 2014, it was a camp for parish officials, during this camp I felt a great belonging to the place and the people, and I felt a love for the service and the way of work provided by the General Secretariat. I had a great desire at the time to join and to be a part of this service that is offered with love. Then I found that God's will was like mine. After this camp for a while, I was nominated to be a representative of the parish of Zababdeh after the previous person's service had ended. I didn't remember that I even thought about it. However, I accepted this invitation without thinking. It was the most important vocation in my life that will not be forgotten and will not stop.

My journey began with the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in Palestine in the year 2014–2015, by being responsible for the university and working committee in Palestine. This year was full of simple activities and the spirit of teamwork (one of the main reasons to succeed in any activity). Then in 2016, it was a very special year for us, the Youth of Jesus' HomeLand (YJHP), we participated in the World Youth Days in Poland. This experience was full of special experiences, but what made the most impact was that one night we slept in an outside place waiting for His Holiness Pope Francis with love. When I attended the mass and heard his words, I felt a great inner and spiritual feeling, that one of my dreams became true, which is to meet Pope Francis one day.

In 2016 and 2017, I was the head of the elementary committee, and in 2018, I was the head of the secondary committee. worked with wonderful people, we worked together even on small details, and stayed up late. We were also tired, we cried and laughed together! We gave everything we have to serve God and the church. We always used to say that the way we work is crazy! A work that is full of love, and sacrifice. Our work was full of planning, organizing, and strong management

for every event that happened within each activity or camp! These years were very important for two main reasons: firstly I was always close to God and secondly my personal life became healthier and filled with people whose hearts were full of love and service. During these years, YJHP family was the closest to my heart, and still, my attention was directed to it without any other disruption. Every time when I get tired, I say to myself that I don't want to continue, that I want to guit, but also every time our Lord does not allow me to deal with these feelings, and my heart doesn't obey my mind, because I can't stay away from this service.

I want to mention the name of one of the camps that I was responsible for during my service, a camp that had, in particular, a great impact on me. It was a secondary camp entitled "Flash Your Lights". The general idea of this camp was that, "The car flashes the light when it wants to change its wrong way", and we also had to flash the light and change our way to go to the right path that will lead us to Jesus. Every part of it supported this idea. This camp was full of meetings, activities, games, ideas, and verses from The Holy Bible and the sayings of the saints. Even the words of the hymn we wrote had a part saying "It is time to take my decision, my life changes, you are the one who is with me now and every day" and we called it "Our Youth Friend". The impact of this camp was great because of the real changes that we saw in people who were almost lost in their period of life, so the fatigue of this camp was crowned with the real joy!

In 2019, I was chosen to be the Vice General Secretary. Great responsibility with the YJHP administration! I hesitated a lot, and as usual I could not refuse, on the contrary, I said "yes" and strongly! And this decision was one of the most beautiful decisions I made in my life. I lived in cooperation among the members of the YJHP administration and with great love towards each member of the family of Jesus Homeland! It was a very special spiritual and social life. This life encouraged us to complete the crazy work we used to dedicate in the camps and activities from the children category to the working category with new hymns, and a huge festival in Palestine! And every time we used to feel fear before any activity, the activity was successful as if the hands of our Lord were present in it! Our Lord accompanied us in every step without exception. One of the most beautiful feelings is to see the blessing in the work and effort you provide and to feel that there are actually many people who have touched a real change in their lives and have become closer to the church because of the army of Jesus' homeland.

2019 was a special year for me. In 2019, I was one of the representatives of the Middle East in the Vatican. There I met Pope Francis. That moment is impossible to forget. I remember the longing and the waiting to see him. It is not possible for me to forget the words of His Holiness the Pope to me. He said to me: "The youth of Palestine and the youth of the Holy Land are always in my prayers". And this year, and its adventures with me were completed at the moment when decided to travel to study my MA in Britain. This means that

I was supposed to leave the youth! In those moments, I felt sad and indeed I travelled, but my heart was always with my family and for this reason, after accomplishing my studies in Britain, I came back and completed this journey with the YJHP.

It is very difficult to write about my experience I lived with my family "the youth of Jesus' HomeLand", it is difficult to express the times that I went through with them. It wasn't only for days or months, it was for years. Years full of work, adventure, joy, courage, and great love without any interest. We always used to say "together we can", because when we are together, the Lord is always with us. And then, the word "impossible" does not exist between us.

My wish for this family is to grow more and more, and for the youth's journey to continue without interruption. I am sure that this is the same will of our Lord; to always be close to Him, to work with love and without any return, in order to attract those around us to live this love. Very soon, I will marry the one with whom I spent many days in youth, and youth was and still is a large part of our lives. The family that we will build together, will surely be part of the youth of Jesus' homeland and the youth of Jesus' homeland will always be in my heart forever. We always used to say, "The youth of Jesus' homeland ... We are ready all the time." And now I say to those after me, always be on this promise that we made together, because our Heavenly Father is always ready to strengthen us to grow."

participated for the first time in the activities of the General Secretariat of Christian Youth in a summer camp for the elementary group in the Talitha Kumi monastery. I don't remember anything of this camp other than the joy that came from Christ. Then, in 2016, I participated in the "Follow Me without anything" camp. This camp was for me an essential camp because it gave me the ability to move from one holy place to another in short periods of time. I remember our journey from the place of the Annunciation in Nazareth to Tiberias, Cana, Capornaum. What made this camp so important to me was that at that time I had many questions and I had lost the meaning of being a Christian. Unfortunately, I even

denied my faith and rejected it publicly because I really did not understand why we should believe, why God created us, and why we suffer. In 2017, I participated in a youth camp, and I found a lecture presented by Fr. Iyad Twal that the Church wants us to ask and to believe, not contrary to reason and logic, but through them we can reach true faith.

In 2019, I participated in the "Adventure of Time" activity. remember feeling God's love within me through the participants, and then I made the decision to believe even if I did not find answers to all my questions. Then I participated in the working committee in order to follow him and live his words in my life. but unfortunately, I came back to doubt and moved away again for a whole year. This year was the hardest in my personal life. The most difficult was not financially or career, on the contrary, it was the best, but it was the worst because I rejected the presence of God in my life despite my knowledge of his presence by my side, I rejected him! Nevertheless, God kept his promise and did not abandon me. In the working group camp, "Now to Where?" 2021 When I went to it I didn't know where I was going, but by participating in this camp, I fully realised everything, I realised his love for us. Through the youth and through my church I knew God more and more, my personal prayer became an essential part, and through reading God's words, I say with full faith and certainty, as Andrew said to his brother Peter: "We have found




